Lisa Smith (violin)

Lisa began learning the violin at the age of 4. She graduated from Churchlands Senior High School and won the top instrumentalist prize in year 12, granting her the opportunity to perform as a soloist in the Perth Convention Centre.

Lisa recently graduated with a Bachelor of Music from the University of Western Australia’s Conservatorium of Music where she was awarded the Ann Brett Scholarship. Lisa received many awards during her time studying including the Lynn Kan Memorial Prize awarded to the student with the highest aggregate mark in performance, the Flora Bunning Prize for first place with her piano trio JULIA and she was a recipient of a Wesley Music Scholarship in 2023.

In 2022, Lisa emerged as a top three finalist in the VOSE competition at the University of Western Australia, winning the People’s Choice Award.

She currently holds the Principal Concertmaster position with a2. orchestra, as well as performing with the West Australian Symphony Orchestra (WASO).

Last year, Lisa performed Tchaikovsky’s Violin Concerto with a2. orchestra at the Government House Ballroom and is eager to advance her studies and enhance her performance career next year.
